ACTION PLAN 2021-2022

THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE STUDENT PARLIAMENT SHALL:

- ✧ Work to ensure that The University of Oslo's (UiO) climate and environmental work is ambitious and comprehensive and in line with the sustainable development goals, and that the university's coming climate and environmental strategy sets clear targets and has clear measures to achieve these. The climate and environmental work must safeguard and prioritize students' interests, as well as lead to a rapid and significant reduction of the university's total climate footprint.
- ✧ Actively work to ensure that all students at UiO have good prerequisites for a high-quality education and an adequate learning outcome, through quality assurance of teaching and curriculum.
- ✧ Work to ensure a high degree of student involvement in Circle U., as well as a consistent student representation in the European University project through the work with The Circle U. Student Union.
- ✧ Work for a more diverse, equal, and inclusive university. UiO must be a natural meeting point for all students, staff, and visitors. UiO must actively work to ensure universal design and the right to individual facilitation.
- ✧ Work to ensure that UiO students' rights and learning environment are safeguarded and strengthened, especially considering the Covid pandemic.
- ✧ Work to strengthen local democracy and ensure consistent student involvement at the university.
- ✧ Work to rebuild, assist and strengthen student volunteering at UiO, as well as working towards start-up grants for new associations.
- ✧ The Student Parliament will cooperate in organizing a cross-party national demonstration for increased student support in connection with the governmental negotiations. The demonstration shall, as far as possible, be done in collaboration with all student democracies and relevant interest organizations.
- ✧ Work to ensure UiO implements a targeted initiative on work relevance, and that this becomes a central part of education and research at UiO.
